MEMBERS CONSENT & USE/RETENTION OF MEDIA

The Gilbern Owners Club (hereinafter “GOC”, “the Club”) exists to support the continued existence of Gilbern Cars, assisting owners to maintain and restore their cars, and record and protect the history and legacy of the Gilbern company. GOC activities continue to generate a large volume of digital media, images, documents and electronic records in many varied formats. This policy is intended to outline members consent for the retention and use of all such data, documents and images for the current and future use by the Club in relation to its stated purpose and objectives.

By joining the Club all members consent to the GOC using all digital media, documents, images, photographs and/or video recordings submitted to the Club’s publications, forums and web platforms, and any images of members and their vehicles or associated items taken by the Club or by persons or organisations authorised on behalf of the Club at events, activities or gatherings organised by, or attended by the Club, for the purposes of promoting the Club or promoting the preservation and continued use of Gilbern Cars.

Any such documents or images can be used in any media (existing or later created or made available) including print & digital media formats, publications, brochures, websites, posters, banners, advertising, film, social media, or for educational or research purposes in relation to the Club’s activities.

Members understand that images on websites can be viewed throughout the world and not just in the United Kingdom and that some overseas countries may not provide the same level of protection to the rights of individuals as the current UK legislation provides.

Members consent that articles, forum posts, documents, images or recordings may be kept permanently after initial use and will form part of the Club’s archive.

Members agree that:-

- They will not receive any payment in respect of the use made of any photograph(s) and/or video recording(s).
- The Club shall have the right to edit, modify, crop, add to or subtract from the photographs and/or video recordings at its entire discretion and without prior approval.
- Copyright of all media, documents, images and/or video recordings will be retained by the Club.

The Club is committed to processing information in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).
